DPG PRESS COVERAGE:

We use a u3a laptop for showing members' pics at our meetings and other demonstrations. All photographs contributed by individual members are kept and archived in the DPG's section which is password protected and no personal details are held on this laptop.

By contributing pics, members agree for them to be published by the NNu3a and/or the DPG, free of copyright. For example, the u3a may ask us for photographs for their newsletter, web site or meetings and members' favourite pics are displayed each month on the HKVH web site.

Each month, members can elect a favourite pic from their individual monthly submissions. Each favourite is labelled with the relevant member's name, then all these monthly 'favourites' are distributed to the editor of the NNu3a Newsletter, the High Kelling Village Hall web site and the editor of Rose Villa Publications, publishers of the Holt Chronicle, the Cromer Times, the Sheringham Independent and the North Walsham Times.

Normally, the HKVH site publish all our favourites each month. The editors of the u3a Newsletter and RV publications, pick as few or as many as they wish, given their opinion and space available. We send them <u>all</u> the DPG favourites in a given month, and the editors alone decide which pics, if any, they will use.

Should you not want your individual pics distributed in this way, free of copyright, please let us know so we can exclude them. Just state 'No Favourite' when submitting your pics for inclusion on the Viewing Platform. This will help save our time chasing you for your selected favourite if not advised at the time of submission.

By specifying a favourite, which we hope you will continue to do, we will assume that means we have your permission to distribute to those 3 channels; u3a including their newsletter, High Kelling Village Hall web site and Rose Villa publications. We remain committed to only distributing your photographs through channels you approve of, but we are proud of our members commitment and skills which we are more than happy to share with others. Should that situation change, we will advise all members accordingly.
